

CROCHETED FISH POTHOLDER: STEP-BY-STEP PATTERN & STITCHES

1 MATERIALS



Cotton yarn



Crochet hook



Tapestry needle



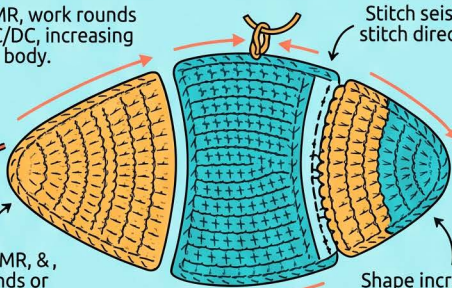
Polyfill (optional)

1 CREATE BODY (Make 2 pieces)

Start with MR, work rounds or row HDC/DC, increasing to form the body.



Start with MR, &, work rounds or rows of HDC/DC.



Stitch session stitch direction.

Shape increases in head & center

2 STITCH GUIDE

MAGIC RING (MR)



CHAIN (CH)



SINGLE CROCHET (SC)



HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (HDC)



DOUBLE CROCHET (DC)



INCREASE (INC)



DECREASE (DEC)



SLIP STITCH (SL ST)



2 ADD FINS & TAIL

Top Dorsal Fin:

Ch 6, SC in 2nd ch, DC in next, &; SC in next, etc.



Pectoral Fins:

Ch 6, SC in 2n 2nd ch, DC in next, etc.
&.: SC in 2n sird ch, DC in next, etc.



Tail Fin:

Ch 6, SC in 2nd ch, DC in next, 2nch ch, DC in next, etc.



3 FORM FEATURES

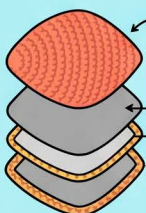


EYE
Magic Ring with black & white yarn



SCALES
Surface slip stitches or alternating loops

4 ASSEMBLY & FINISHING



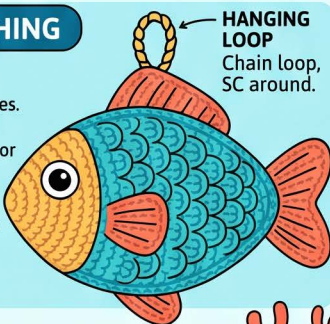
Stack the two main body pieces.

Place heat-resistant lining or extra crochet layers inside.

Join edges with single crochet or crab stitch.

HANGING LOOP

Chain loop, SC around.
